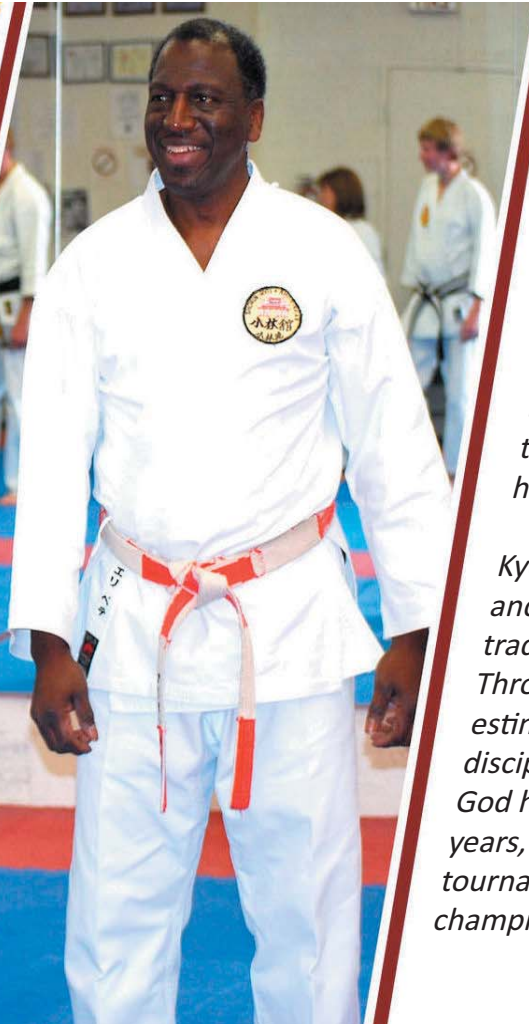




Southwest Center for the Martial Arts Proudly Presents Combat Karate Seminar with Kyoshi Eddie Bethea
